Summary

This document reports the first - Kick-off meeting of the Erasmus+ Capacity Building in the Field of Higher Education project "Development of master curricula for natural disasters risk management in Western Balkan countries" (NatRisk), held at the coordinating University of Nis, on the 15th and 16th of December 2016. The meeting was chaired by Assist. Prof. Milan Gocić. The objective was to introduce to all project partners the most relevant issues of project implementation.

1. First day

The first day of the kick-off meeting was divided into three sessions:

- First session Opening (open for academic public and press)
- Second session Introducing project management, monitoring, reporting, financial reporting and technical details
- > Third session Partner presentations with special emphasis on their HE research potential and practices, as well as role in NatRisk

1.1 First session

After the welcome speech given by the Rector of the University of Niš, Prof. Dragan Antić and having the participants acquainted with the history of the development of the University of Niš by Prof. Vesna Lopičić, vice-rector of the University of Niš, Assis. Prof. Milan Gocić from the University of Niš presented the project to all participants. The most significant project segments were highlighted at this occasion and so the presentation represented an introduction to all following meeting sessions.

1.2 Second session

The second session was opened with the presentation of the Erasmus Plus programme given by Mr. Darko Milogorić, the representative of Serbian Erasmus Office. Mr. Milogorić presented some basic information on the programme, contractual and financial obligations of beneficiaries, clarification of costs eligibility and other issues relevant for the successful implementation of the project. The presentation concerning the Project finance and financial reporting was given by Assist. Prof. Saša Nikolić who informed the partners that the presented information regarding the financial management of the project was obtained from the Grant Agreement and Work Programme of Erasmus Plus. Prof. Dejan Rančić presented the project website and project management platform which will be used throughout the project lifetime. In continuation, Prof. Ivica Manić presented the special mobility strand. A part of presentation was dedicated to elaboration of types of mobilities as well as to the inter-institutional agreement preparation.

1.3 Third session

During this part, each of the project partners gave a brief presentation of their institution. The goal of these presentations was to provide the participants with the opportunity to learn more about the other institutions participating in the project and their expertise and experience relevant for the successful implementation of the project activities. 2. Second day

On the second day, the partner institutions discussed the contractual, technical and practical aspects of the NatRisk project implementation. The second day agenda included:

Establishing of the project management structures

- ➤ Quality Assurance Committee (four members from four NatRisk partner institution UNI, MUHEC, OE, BOKU),

The NatRisk Consortium adopted the decision on the establishment of management structures. The Decision was sent to all project partners and it is a part of these Minutes as Annex I.

Presentations of work packages

During this part, each work package leader gave a preview of the work package. The presentations included general information on each WP such as the duration of the WP, main objectives, list and short description of activities and expected outcomes with set deadlines.

Administrative issues (meeting with the WB HEIs)

During this part, the consultation between team from UNI and other WB HEIs was held. Representatives discussed future implementation of NatRisk project activities.

Overview of the first project year: work plan, tasks and obligations of partners

In order to initiate project activities successfully and in accordance with the defined dynamics, the work plan, tasks and obligations of partners were discussed and reviewed. The action plan included the list of project activities that need to be initiated in the first project year. Each activity was followed by a deadline and a list of participating partners.
