Event title	Meeting NatRisk project team and legal representatives of local government of the north Kosovo I Mtohija.

Event description:

On March 17th 2018 prof. dr Nebojsa Arsic, dean of FTS, prof. dr Srdjan Jovic, vicedean, and doc. Dr Jelena Djokic held meeting on the FTS UPKM in purpose to promote training for citizens and public sector within NatRisk project with head of the Kosovsko-Mitrovacki district, Mr Vaso Jelic. During the meeting Erasmus + NatRisk project for Capacity Building in Higher Education (Development of master curricula for natural disaster risk management in Western Balkan countries) was presented.

NatRisk Erasmus + project was approved on 2016 by EACEA (Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency) and it lasts three years. Partner Institutions from EU countries are University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences, Vienna (Austrija); Middlesex University Higher Education Corporation, London (UK); University of Messina, Messina (Italy); Óbuda University, Budapest (Hungary); Technical University of Crete, Chania (Greece). Partner Institutions from WEB countries on the project are University of Banja Luka, University of Nis (coordinator of the project), University of Defence in Belgrade, University of Priština temporarily settled in Kosovska Mitrovica, Criminalistic-Police Academy from Belgrade and Technical Collage of Applied Sciences - Urosevac with temporary seat in Leposavić.

The Main aim of the NatRisk project is the education of future experts for prevention and management of natural disaster risk in the Western Balkan region, based on the national and EU policies. The specific aims within the project are: Identification which kind of natural disasters are the most important for managing in the WEB region and all the aspects for prevention and consequences in the purpose to define certain competences for future educated experts; Developing and implementation the new master curricula on the field of natural disaster risk management according to Bologna's requests and national standards for accreditation; Training for public sector and citizens for responding to natural disasters.

Representatives of public sector expressed strong interest for NatRisk project goal to educate this profile of experts, who lack in the municipalities and region of the North Kosovo and Metohija. They also pointed out the need for joint actions within the project activities and necessity for mutual cooperation in order to

achieve the set goals of the project. The need for new employees in local and regional bodies regarding the natural disasters risk treatment was also highlighted. Project team used this opportunity to invite all employees in department for urbanization, inspection, occupational safety, forestry and waterpower engineering as well as employees in fire station and administration for emergency situations to participate training for citizens and public sector which will be organized within NatRisk project on the Faculty of Technical sciences UPKM. Local government showed interest for students' internship in local institutions, which they should attend during the term of the project.
