

#### Results of general evaluation of master curriculum








#### Results of evaluation the general student expectations

#### Description

For 75% of students overall impression is rated as excellent. 33.33% thinks the presentations are very good and 66.67% that they are excellent. The scope of material for 41.67% of the students is excellent and 8.33% think it is good; for the rest of the students, 50% it is very good. Tempo is excellent for 75% of students. The majority of students, 75% thinks that laboratory equipment is very good. No negative remarks on this item. Practical exercises are considered excellent for 50% of students; whereas 8.33% think they are good; for 41.67% of students are very good. 66.67% of students are fully satisfied with the programme, i.e., their expectations have been completely met.








#### Results of evaluation of possibility of participation in student mobility

#### Description
