

Training description:	

The main objectives of the training were successfully aimed at raising public awareness of the real danger of natural disasters and their consequences, understanding the importance of the role of society and the individual in preventing and mitigating the consequences of natural disasters, and getting acquainted with the importance and significance of building a culture of long-term natural disaster risk management through defining normative-legal framework and the establishment of an integrated, functional, and efficient system of responsible institutions and participants.

The participants of the training were introduced to the natural disasters, their causes, as well as their direct and indirect consequences, with particular reference to the natural disasters that most often affect the Republic of Serbia. Special attention was paid to the contemporary methodology of natural disaster risk assessment and management in terms of measures and activities that should be undertaken with the aim of preventing and mitigating the effects of natural disasters. The training was also dedicated to emergency procedures in case of a natural disaster event, the normative–legal framework for the engagement of subjects of the protection and rescue system, responsible institutions and the role of the individual - citizen, as well as short-term and long-term post-disaster measures and activities.



Results of evaluation the general organisation of the training








Results of evaluation the general participant expectations

Participants' expetations were quite met, with all fields rated above 4.40. There was a remark regarding greater need for Practical exercises.


