Training description:	
<p>This document reports the first Training for citizens and public sector of the Erasmus+ Capacity Building in the Field of Higher Education project „Development of master curricula for natural disasters risk management in Western Balkan countries “(NatRisk), held at the University of Defence in Belgrade (UNID), on the June 14th 2018.</p> <p>The training was chaired by Prof. Colonel Rade Slavkovic.</p> <p>The objective was to introduce to participants the most relevant issues of natural disasters in Serbia and how to prevent them. Also, participants were inform about the skills they need to develop for adequate reactions in such situations, in order to protect and save people, material and other goods endangered by epidemics and large-scale fires.</p> <p>Thirty-two participants from fourteen institutions were present at one-day training.</p> <p>The participants of the training were introduced with the types of natural disasters as well as the causes of their occurrence. Special attention was given to natural disasters that most often affect Republic of Serbia.</p> <p>This training was focused on epidemics and large-scale fires.</p> <p>The participants were introduced with direct and indirect consequences occurred due to epidemics and large-scale fires.</p> <p>During the training there was a discussion regarding the modern methodology used for risk assessment and risk management in case of epidemics and large-scale fires, and of course, regarding measures and activities, which need to be undertaken for prediction, prevention and mitigation of consequences.</p> <p>Participants were introduced with the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the definition of natural disasters and the types of disasters, - the types of natural disasters that most often affect Republic of Serbia, - how to behave during and after epidemics and large-scale fires occurs, - which structures should be involved in the defense from epidemics and large-scale fires, - how to mitigate the consequences of epidemics and large-scale fires, - actions in emergencies. <p>At the end of the training, members of Belgrade Fire Brigade demonstrated the procedure of fire extinguishing and the use of specialized vehicles. They also showed the means which they use in such situations.</p>

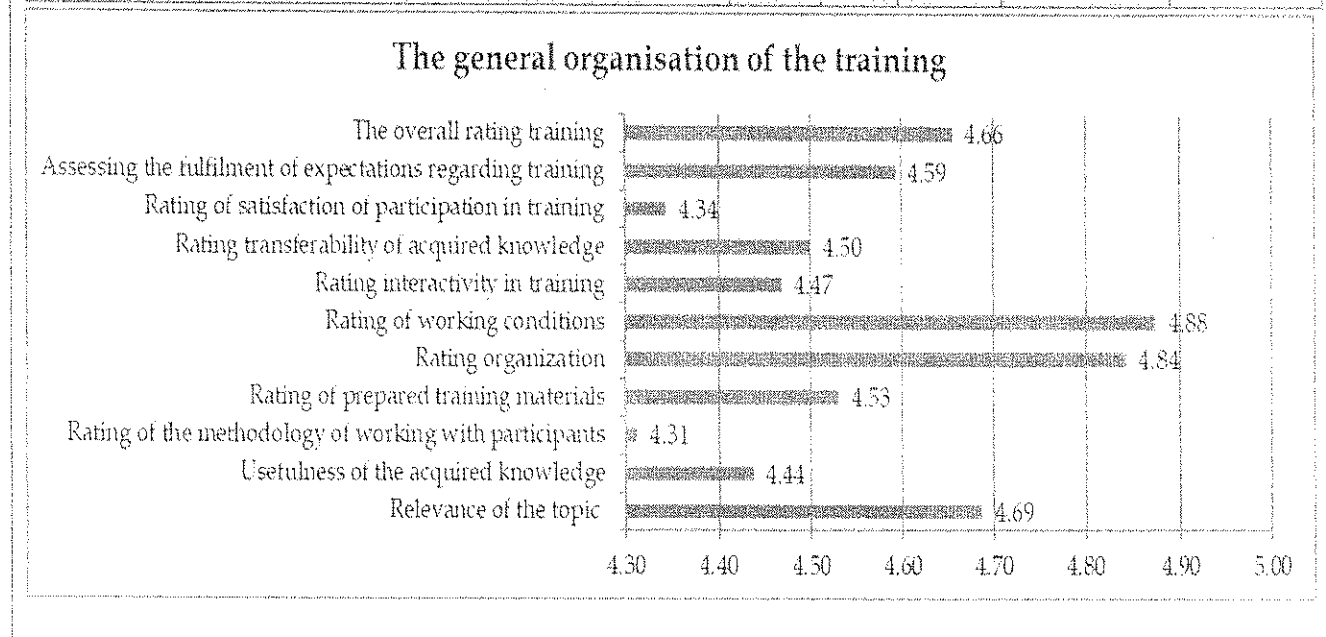

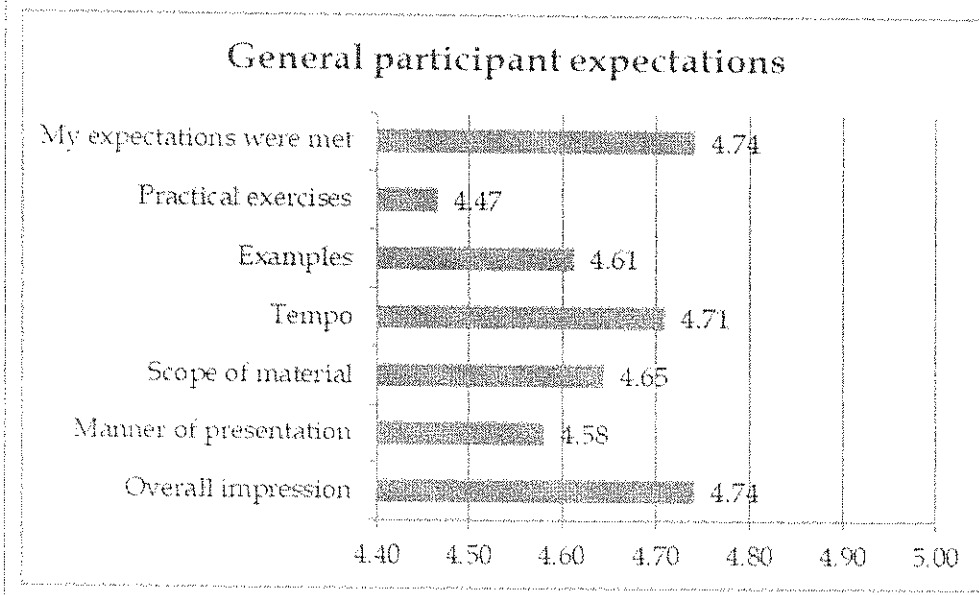


