



REPORT ON IMPLEMENTED FIRST TRAINING FOR CITIZENS AND PUBLIC SECTOR


During the six organized trainings, 244 participants or 34 participants more than planned in project proposal were trained from 93 different institutions in the field of natural disasters risk management. The large number of involved stakeholders suggests that the topic of trainings is of great importance for them and the trainings can be sustainable after the project funding.




Number of participants per WB HEI




Percentage of trained persons per WB HEI



Number of different participated institutions per WB HEI After organized trainings, WB HEIs prepared self-evaluation report of training for citizens and public sector according to the received evaluation lists. Evaluation list for selfevaluation of trainings contained three groups of questions classified as 1) general organisation of the training (11 questions), 2) general participant expectations (7 questions) and 3) evaluation of trainer (6 questions).
